

At this time, the maximum CNE that can be earned while participating in the the 2020 pre-convention and convention educational activities is 37.25 nursing contact hours attainable as follows:

- Preconvention Sessions (fee additional): 12.25 hours
- Sunday: 2.25 hours
- Monday: 5.0 hours
- Tuesday: 4.0 hours
- Wednesday: 4.0 hours
- Posters: 9.75 hours (that can be earned both at poster sessions and throughout the open hours of the poster room)
